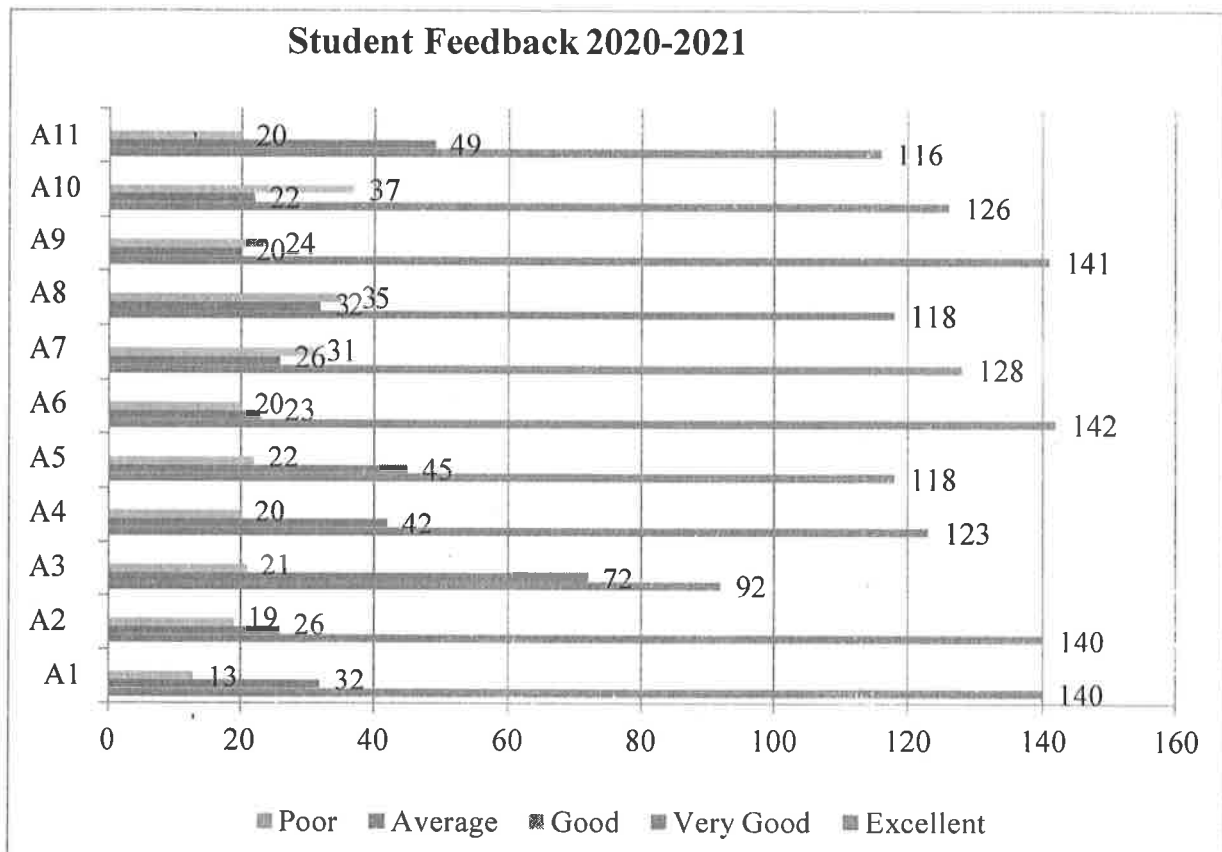
### 1. ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS FEEDBACK

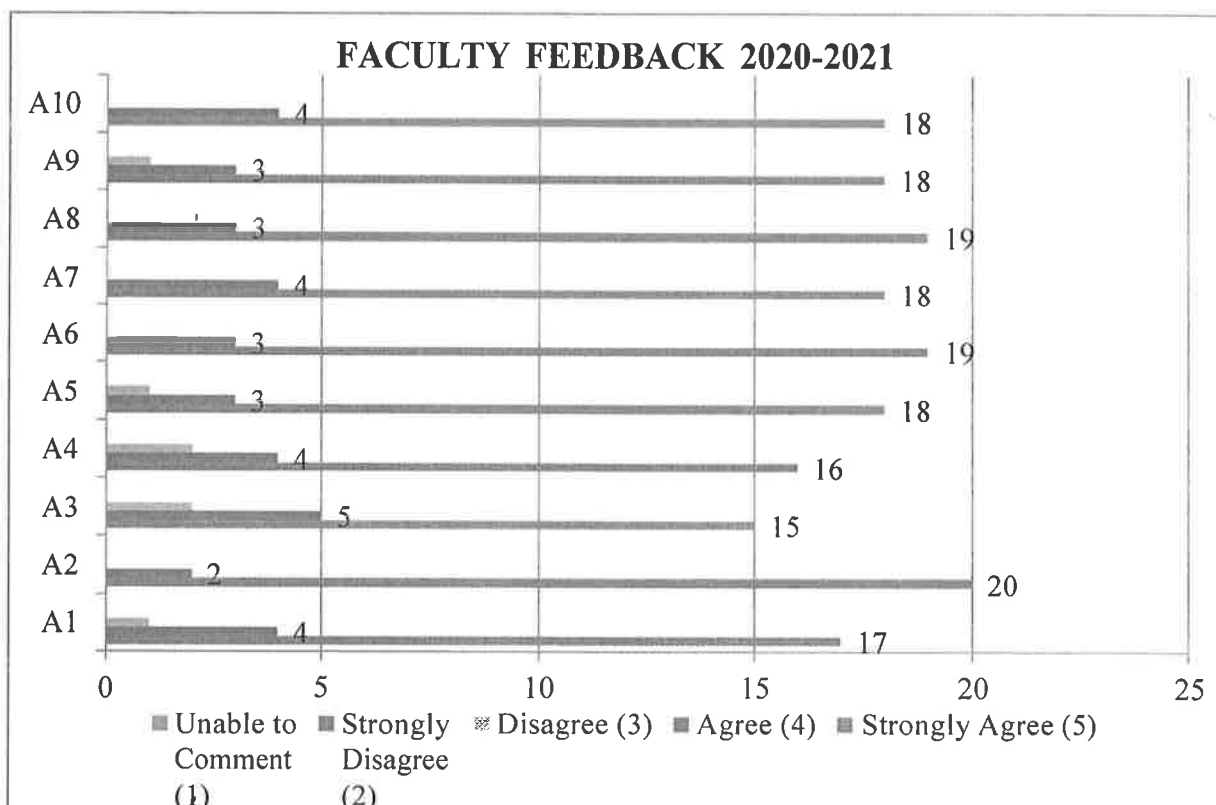

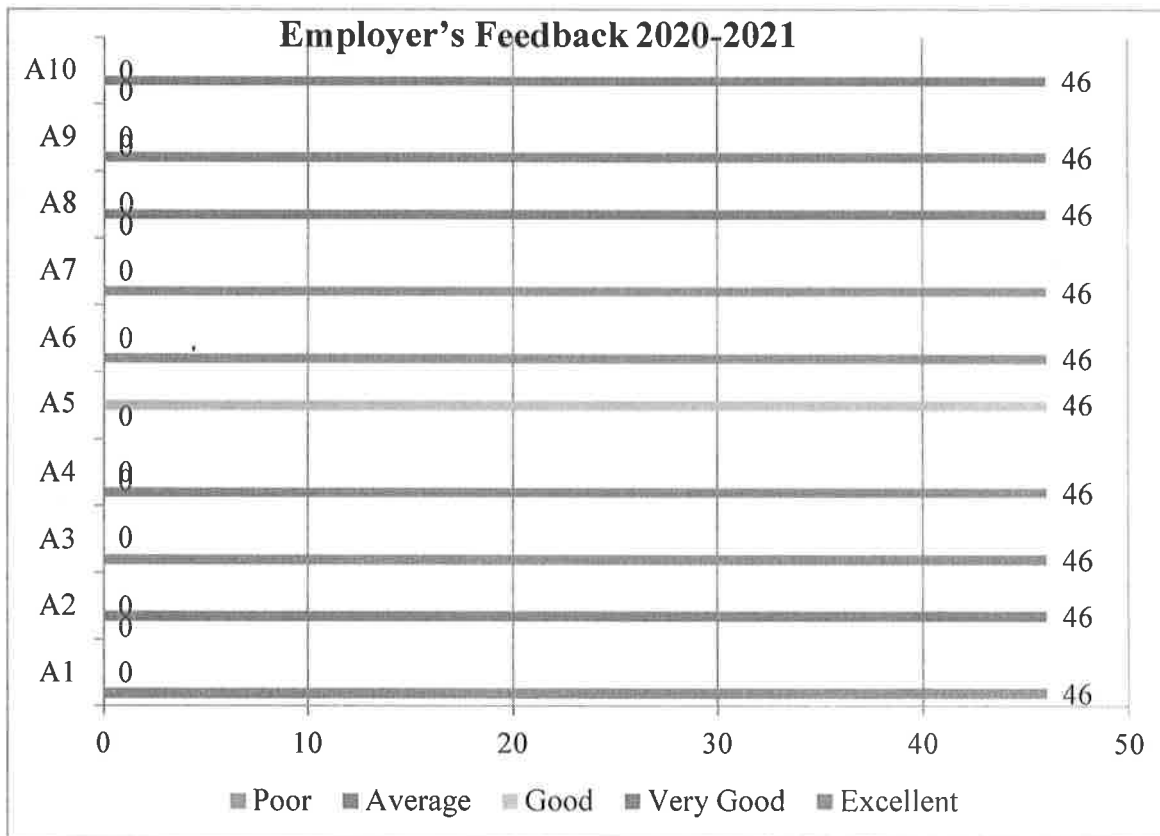

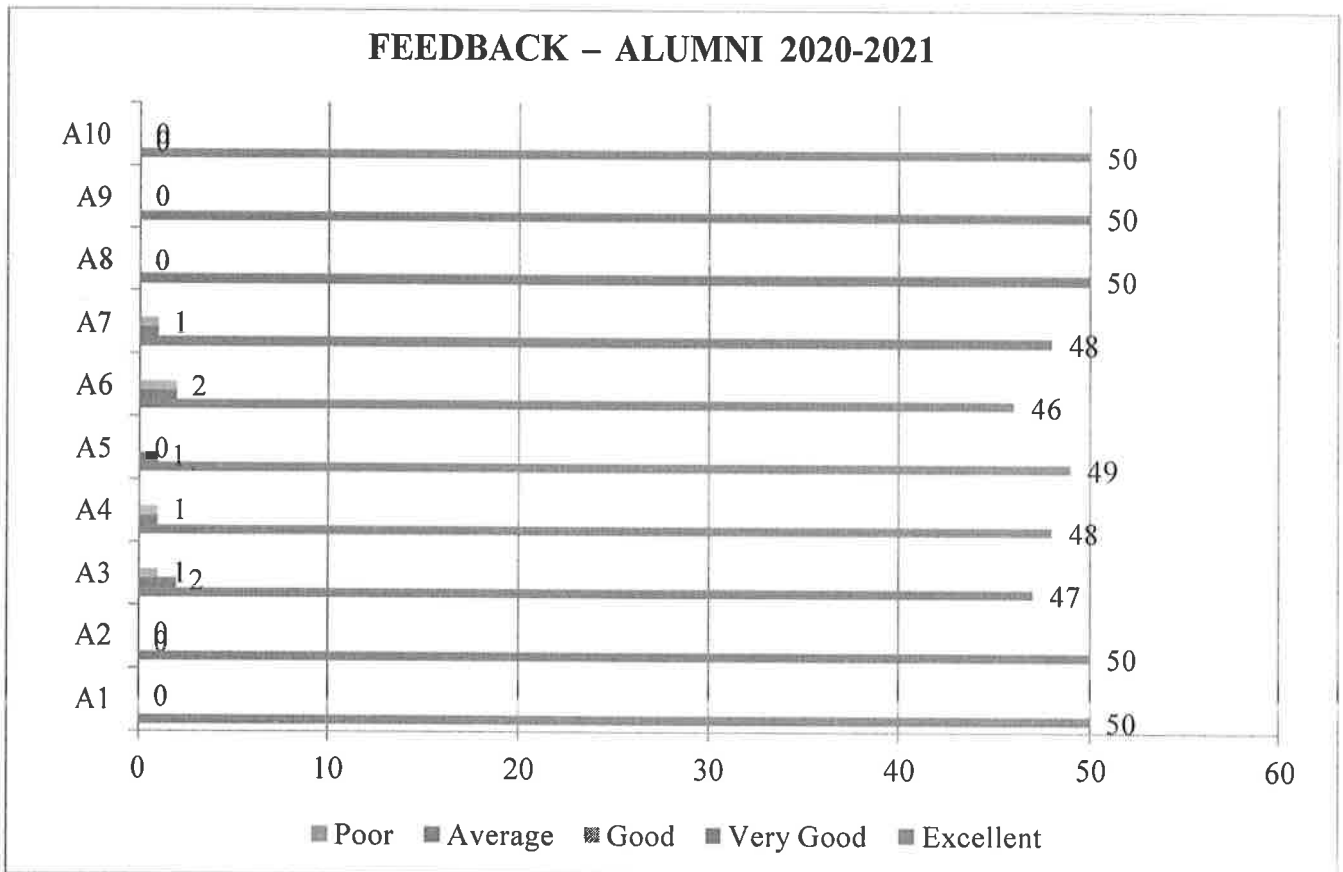
